You may be eligible for financial aid from a variety of sources, including federal, state, and Lon Morris College funds.

APPLY FOR ADMISSION

If you have not already received an application in the mail, contact our office or go online and complete the application process at www.lonmorris.edu.

SUBMIT YOUR FREE APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL STUDENT AID (FAFSA)

Complete the FAFSA online at www.fafsa.ed.gov. The Financial Aid Office will determine your eligibility for additional state and federal aid. Plan to complete the FAFSA as soon as possible after January 1st of each year that you plan to attend college.

RETURN YOUR FINANCIAL AID AWARD LETTER FROM LON MORRIS COLLEGE

When the above steps are completed, you will receive an award letter outlining your financial aid award(s) from Lon Morris College, if eligible. Sign and return all missing documents listed on the Award Letter to the Financial Aid Office to secure your awards.

Federal Pell Grant	Up to \$4,731	Eligibility and consideration for Federal and State financial aid requires completion of the Free Application for Student Aid (FAFSA) with Lon Morris College as a recipient of this information. Lon Morris College's Federal School Code is 003585. It is highly recommended to submit your FAFSA every year as soon after January 1st as possible, as various types of aid are subject to date of receipt of FAFSA information. SAT score requirements for scholarships are based on the Critical Reading and Math subsection scores combined.

- GPA Based on 4.0 Scale
- All Scholarships/Awards Listed Above Require Full-Time Enrollment Status
- Annual Amount is Based on Fall and Spring Enrollment, and Awarded by Semester
- A Departmental or Activity can be combined with a Lon Morris College Academic Scholarship. A student can receive only one Departmental or Activity Award, but can participate in as many activities as they choose.
- Lon Morris College's Athletic Scholarships/Activities Awards cannot be combined with Lon Morris College's Academic Scholarships.
- Lon Morris College's three United Methodist Scholarships cannot be combined with each other. The United Methodist Bishop's Scholarship cannot be combined with a Lon Morris College Academic Scholarship. Student must maintain 2.25 cumulative GPA to receive the scholarship their 2nd year.
- Students transferring to Lon Morris College with 24 college credits are eligible for an Academic Transfer.
- Lon Morris College's scholarships, awards, and financial aid are awarded based on availability of funds.
